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HOW TO USE THIS HANDBOOK

Plan 40 is a 40-day (6-week) journey preparing us - in prayer and in ourselves - for the greatest possible Life Class and Encounter Weekend. Each chapter carries the week's biblical foundation, memory verse and full teaching, and closes with the goals to work toward before the next session. Work through them with your triplet.

THE OVERALL GOAL: Each guide registers 10 people for Life Class and guides them through to their Encounter Weekend.

THE PRIVILEGE OF BEING CALLED

Understanding the honour of being called by God to be an Encounter guide.

BIBLICAL FOUNDATION

"The LORD had said to Abram, 'Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you. I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you.'"

- Genesis 12:1-3 (NIV)

MEMORY VERSE

"I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing."

- Genesis 12:2 (NIV)

OBJECTIVES

Help the leaders become aware of the privilege it is to be called by God to be an Encounter guide.

Introductory Question: Are you sure of your calling?

MESSAGE CONTENT

What Is Plan 40?

40 DAYS - SIX WEEKS to prepare - in prayer and in ourselves - for the greatest possible Life Class and Encounter. You have already had your own encounter; now you step in to let God use you to win others and guide them toward theirs. The aim is **TRUE CONVERSION**: genuinely born again, redeemed, renewed and restored - not merely an emotional decision at an altar call.

Who Is This For?

People who have already been through Encounter and Life Class, are not yet cell leaders, but want to take the next step. Over these six weeks you are trained to be a **GUIDE**. You bring people along to the cell you already attend - you don't need your own cell group yet.

1. WIN

2. PRESERVE

3. GUIDE

4. MULTIPLY

1. **Win:** Reach and pray for people with the gospel.
2. **Preserve:** Care for them so the decision lasts.
3. **Guide:** Walk them through Life Class and Encounter.
4. **Multiply:** In time, start your own cell group.

Why Encounter Matters: The Five Objectives

1. **TRUE REPENTANCE:** Genuine brokenness - turning from a life of sin and turning to the Lord.
2. **INNER HEALING:** Restoration from past trauma; God restores His original design over you.
3. **DELIVERANCE:** Chains broken; oppression and addictions removed by the power of Jesus.
4. **BAPTISM OF THE SPIRIT:** Baptised with the fire and power of the Holy Spirit.
5. **VISION:** Spiritual eyes opened to see and pursue the perfect will of the Father.

The Lesson: The Call of Abraham

A calling is a gift from God for each of His children. Abraham was not looking to be called - the Lord revealed Himself and called him. Although the call came directly from God, Abraham still had to decide whether he would believe the call, and if he was willing to obey and pursue the path God was marking out for him. Notice the very first word God spoke: **"GO."** At some point the dream or plan has to become an action word. The process doesn't start by hoping - it starts by taking a step of faith. God rarely gives the full details of the destination; He gives the **NEXT STEP**.

God also said to leave your country, your people and your father's household - leave what is comfortable and familiar. What God has is so large it can't be carried with old thinking and old company. If you want change from God, God expects change from you; to whom much is given, much is required.

Four Attributes in Abraham's Response

1. **Immediate obedience:** Abraham did not delay; he immediately obeyed the divine calling.
2. **Total obedience:** Abraham did not only obey in some things; he obeyed every word the Lord had spoken to him.
3. **Genuine faith:** Abraham's faith was as pure as a child's with no Plan B. Despite the circumstances, he did not doubt even one of all the promises God had given him.
4. **Perseverance:** Abraham stood firm in his faith until he received the promise of God - why it's Plan 40, not Plan 1.

Many Are Called, Few Are Chosen

Why are few chosen? Because they refuse to answer the call. A call is like a ringing phone: you press the green button or the red button - and **LEAVING IT TO RING IS THE SAME AS PRESSING RED**. To not answer is to reject the call. God found you; you didn't find Him. Are you affirmed in your calling, and prepared to answer while the phone is still ringing?

Two Blessings of Answering

- **It pleases God:** God was so pleased by Abraham's response that He decided to become his close friend. Jesus said we are His friends when we obey His commands (John 15).
- **It fulfils the purpose of God in our lives:** Abraham was able to fulfil his purpose of becoming a father of nations because he responded to the call of God.

1. Write your **PRAYER LIST** using **F.R.A.N.C.E.S.** - Friends, Relatives, Acquaintances, Neighbours, Colleagues, Enemies, Strangers. Aim for at least 10 names using the table below.
2. Pray for that list **EVERY DAY**: "Lord, I bring these names before You; use me in their lives to bring them to salvation in Christ Jesus."
3. **VISIT THREE PEOPLE** from your list this week - spend time with them and let the Lord help you love and care for them.
4. Find out and write down the **LIFE CLASS START DATE** and the **MEN'S and WOMEN'S ENCOUNTER DATES**.
5. Learn the memory verse (Genesis 12:2) and confess the goal: "*I am not a goal-setter; I am a goal-getter.*"

HOLINESS: THE KEY TO RECEIVING GOD'S SUPPORT

Being a prepared vessel of honour that God can use.

BIBLICAL FOUNDATION & MEMORY VERSE

"...to rescue us from the hand of our enemies, and to enable us to serve him without fear, in holiness and righteousness before him all our days."

- Luke 1:74-75 (NIV)

Confess it: "Jesus enables me to live without fear, in holiness and righteousness."

Introductory Question: What benefits does a life of holiness bring?

MESSAGE CONTENT

What Holiness Means

Holiness is to be **CHOSEN BY GOD AND SET APART** to serve Him. It means being **ACCURATE** - living to God's standard - and being a **VESSEL OF HONOUR**. A person who wants to be holy for the Lord cannot at the same time serve sin, bad habits, the world or the flesh.

THE TWO VESSELS (2 TIMOTHY 2)

In the same house there are vessels of honour and dishonour. Picture a feast: two plates - one clean, one dirty. Which do you choose? The clean one, not out of hatred for the other, but because it is **PREPARED FOR ITS PURPOSE**. Being in the house is a great thing - but it is not the same as being prepared for the work.

Characteristics of a Sanctified Leader (Judges 13)

1. **CHOSEN FOR A CRISIS**: Called by God for a specific time and a specific people.
2. **SUPERNATURAL STRENGTH**: Entrusted with divine ability to fulfil the purpose - not our own.
3. **NON-NEGOTIABLE LIMITS**: For a special assignment God gives special requirements.
4. **FREEDOM FOR OTHERS**: Never for your own prominence - always to set others free.

What Can Affect Our Holiness (Judges 15-16)

1. **WALKING IN THE FLESH** - Not according to the Holy Spirit.
2. **PLAYING WITH TEMPTATION** - No parameters to keep you from unsafe places.
3. **OVER-CONFIDENCE IN SELF** - Samson trusted early results and stopped obeying.
4. **BEING UNEQUALLY YOKED** - Ungodly company took his heart from God.
5. **GIVING IN TO PRESSURE** - When you lower the standard, you lose everything.

Consequences of Losing Our Holiness

- **SLAVERY TO YOUR ENEMIES** - Samson was bound and lost his strength.
- **COMPLETE LOSS OF VISION** - They plucked out his eyes; you can no longer see God's dream.
- **PUBLIC MOCKING AND SCORN** - The deliverer became a spectacle.
- **SPIRITUAL DEATH** - He pulled the temple down on himself.

How to Restore Our Holiness

1. REPENT

2. TO THE CROSS

3. RENEW ANOINTING

4. COMMIT

1. **Repent**: Turn from the sin and give it to Christ.
2. **To the Cross**: Take your sin and curse; Jesus bears it.
3. **Renew Anointing**: Psalm 51: restore the joy of Your salvation.
4. **Commit**: Firm faithfulness to God's standard.

When we live in holiness and integrity we attract the support of heaven - divine power and authority - and nothing will be impossible for us. Be the clean vessel in the hand of God.

The Triangle Offense

No one does this alone. Every guide is placed in a **TEAM OF THREE** - our "triangle offense" or **TRIPLET** - for encouragement and accountability. Together you plan three things:

1. **Plan to Pray:** Together, daily, for your prayer lists.
2. **Plan to Invite:** Decide when and where to invite people.
3. **Plan to Preserve:** How you'll consolidate: church, cell, Life Class.

WEEK 2 TO-DO LIST

1. **FORM YOUR TRIPLET** - team up with two other guides (your cell leader or pastor will help).
2. As a triplet, **PLAN TO PRAY:** agree how and when you'll pray together daily for your prayer lists.
3. As a triplet, **PLAN TO INVITE:** decide the event or service you will invite your people to (special cell, miracle catch, Sunday service).
4. As a triplet, **PLAN TO PRESERVE:** agree how you'll consolidate people into church, cell and Life Class.
5. **EXAMINE YOURSELF** before the Lord - repent of anything that compromises holiness, and ask Him to restore His anointing.
6. Keep praying daily over your prayer list and keep adding names.

WHAT DOES BEING A GUIDE MEAN?

Accepting the responsibility of guiding others in their walk with God.

BIBLICAL FOUNDATION

"The righteous choose their friends carefully, but the way of the wicked leads them astray."

- Proverbs 12:26 (NIV)

MEMORY VERSE

"For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God."

- Romans 8:14 (NIV)

Confess: "Because He guides me, I can guide others."

Introductory Question: What does being a guide mean?

MESSAGE CONTENT

The Objective: Accept the Responsibility

Everyone is being led by someone - either God uses us to guide people onto the road of righteousness, or the enemy uses other voices to lead them astray. Today's objective: **ACCEPT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE WORK OF THE KINGDOM**. Are you committed to God using you to lead others into eternal glory - and to see the work through? No one should start a work they won't finish.

"But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth... and he will tell you what is yet to come."

- John 16:13

To be a guide is to be a **REPRESENTATIVE OF HEAVEN, AN AMBASSADOR OF JESUS** in someone else's life. You are not God to them - you represent Him. And the Spirit of truth gives you the right words, the right heart and the strength you need.

The Importance of Preparation

- **SPIRITUALLY** - Go deeper into the Word and your relationship with the Holy Spirit. It's not one big habit but **LITTLE HABITS**: a verse before bed, a 20-second prayer before a meeting. Honour God in small things and He honours you.
- **PERSONALLY** - Be an example, reputable and excellent in everything. We give up certain liberties not only for ourselves but for the sake of those watching us. Your lifestyle, not just your words, becomes the teaching.

A Guide's Attitudes

1. **UPRIGHT**: Clear conscience, no double life - from being in God's presence.
2. **SERVANT-HEARTED**: "The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve" (Mark 10:45).
3. **SUBMISSION**: To God, His Word and your authorities. Say "let me ask my pastor."
4. **AUTHORITY**: From integrity, relationship with God and a good testimony.
5. **RIGHTEOUSNESS**: Act from conviction, not convenience; show no favouritism.
6. **EMPATHY**: Identify with others' struggles. Bind mercy AND truth around your neck.

The Four Places You Guide Someone

1. DEVOTION

2. CELL

3. CHURCH

4. LIFE CLASS

1. **Devotion**: Daily Word and prayer, about 15 minutes (start in John).
2. **Cell**: Their spiritual family - get them there weekly.
3. **Church**: The celebration - present and worshipping.
4. **Life Class**: The 8 lessons, leading to the Encounter weekend.

WEEK 3 TO-DO LIST

1. **MAKE THE COMMITMENT** - formally accept the responsibility of being a guide and of seeing the work through.
2. Build one or two **SMALL DAILY HABITS**: a verse before bed, a short prayer before meetings or appointments.
3. Review your life against the **SIX ATTITUDES** - identify the one you most need to grow in this week.
4. Meet with your **TRIPLET** and confirm the date and place you will invite people to.
5. Keep praying daily over your prayer list; begin conversations with the people on it.
6. Learn Romans 8:14 by heart.

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A HEART AFTER GOD'S OWN HEART

Compassionate, loving, and thirsty for the salvation of souls.

BIBLICAL FOUNDATION

"Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends."

- John 15:13 (NIV)

MEMORY VERSE

"When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick."

- Matthew 14:14 (NIV)

Introductory Question: What is compassionate love?

MESSAGE CONTENT

Love Is a Verb, Not a Feeling

Jesus taught us what true love is when He gave His life for us at Calvary - an example of surrender, compassion and generosity. The greatest love is **NOT AN EMOTION**, a moment or a good feeling; it is an **ACTION**. You can't live your life and lay it down at the same time. To lay it down is to sacrifice comfort and fleshly pleasure in order to get involved in someone else's life. That is what it means to be a guide: **MY LIFE IS FOR OTHERS** - and living for people brings glory to God, because God is about people.

Compassion: Passion for Others

The root of **COMPASSION** is passion - but not for your own ambition. It is passion for your neighbour, your colleague, your enemies, strangers, and people of other cultures and nations. Business gives in order to receive; **LOVE SIMPLY GIVES**, loving people who can do nothing for you. Jesus is the truest example: He could have called a thousand angels but gave His life freely.

Why We Need Love & Compassion

- **IT IS THE DESIRE OF GOD'S HEART** - "I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land... but I found no one" (Ezekiel 22:30). God is searching for someone whose life is for others.
- **IT IS A COMMAND** - "This is my command: love each other" (John 15:17). Loving God and neighbour is the essence of Christianity.

HOSPITALITY TO THE OVERLOOKED

Not hospitality for your friends, but for those neglected by society - the outcasts, the highways and byways, the strangers, the very people Jesus dined with. Only when they are loved will they be open to the gospel.

How to Show Love & Compassion

1. Understanding the condition of man without God.
2. Remembering that God had mercy on us when we were lost.
3. Preaching the gospel with love and patience.
4. Crying out for mercy and for the needs of others - as Daniel did, pleading for his people's sins as if they were his own.

Connect with Compassion

1. IDENTIFY NEED

2. FULFIL NEED

3. INVITE

1. **Identify Need:** Start a conversation; listen for the real need.
2. **Fulfil Need:** Testimony, prayer, a coffee or meal - care for them.
3. **Invite:** To a place they can hear the gospel - arrange transport.

It may take a second or third attempt - be persistent. The success is **TAKING THE STEP OF FAITH**. The Holy Spirit steps in once you step out.

WEEK 4 TO-DO LIST

1. **STEP OUT THIS WEEK** - begin conversations with the people on your prayer list.
2. For each person: **IDENTIFY A NEED** and write it next to their name.
3. **FULFIL A NEED** for at least three people - pray with them, share your testimony, buy them a coffee or a meal.
4. **START INVITING** people to the event or service your triplet agreed on - and arrange their transport.
5. Show hospitality to someone outside your usual circle - invite a neighbour or colleague for a meal or braai.
6. Pray daily for boldness and courage, as the apostles did in Acts 4.

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DEPENDING ON THE HOLY SPIRIT

Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit.

BIBLICAL FOUNDATION & MEMORY VERSE

"The Spirit of the LORD will come powerfully upon you, and you will prophesy with them; and you will be changed into a different person."

- 1 Samuel 10:6 (NIV)

Introductory Question: What does depending on the Holy Spirit mean?

MESSAGE CONTENT

The Power Is Already Upon You

When the Spirit comes, He comes with **POWER** (Acts 1:8) - power to be His witness. Most Christians look at the pastor or the prophet and think "that person has the power of God." No - **WHOEVER HAS THE HOLY SPIRIT HAS THE POWER OF GOD.** You don't need to beg for it; the power, authority and anointing are already upon you. So your confidence is in the Lord, not in yourself.

What Depending on the Holy Spirit Means

1. CONFIDENCE

2. SENSITIVE

3. OBEY

1. **Confidence:** Complete confidence in Him, not in yourself.

2. **Sensitive:** Hear His voice in every situation.

3. **Obey:** Immediately and completely.

Everything depends on Him: if the Lord doesn't build the house we labour in vain. **GOOD NEWS:** God wants to win people far more than you do - the Great Commission is His desire and His zeal. Be willing and available, and you will be astonished at what He does through you. Even when you feel nothing, all of heaven is behind you.

How Can We Depend on the Holy Spirit? (Jeremiah 17:10)

1. **SEARCH THE HEART:** "Show me where I'm deceived." Deception means not knowing you're wrong.

2. **EXAMINE THE MIND:** Tremble at His word (Isaiah 66) and let it renew your mind.

3. **WALK RIGHTLY:** A clear conscience, blameless, no intentional sin.

4. **BEAR FRUIT:** Obey the assignment of the Lord for your life.

NOT BY MIGHT NOR BY POWER

"Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the LORD Almighty."

- Zechariah 4:6

How will I register 10 if I never have before? Not by ability or strength - by the Spirit of God, who specialises in the impossible.

WEEK 5 TO-DO LIST

1. **REGISTER YOURSELF** as a guide for Life Class and the Encounter weekend.
2. **REGISTER THE PEOPLE** you've reached for Life Class - this week, not later.
3. Make sure **EVERY PERSON ON YOUR LIST HAS BEEN INVITED** to a place where they can hear the gospel; catch up on anyone missed.
4. Pray daily: "Holy Spirit, search my heart - show me where I'm deceived," and ask each morning who to call, visit or invite.
5. Practise **LISTENING AND OBEYING** - act on the first prompting He gives you each day.
6. Meet your triplet and report progress toward your goal of 10.

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LAUNCH OUT INTO THE DEEP

Casting the net and becoming fishers of men.

BIBLICAL FOUNDATION & MEMORY VERSE

"When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, 'Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch.'"

- Luke 5:4 (NKJV)

Introductory Question: Where is the Lord asking you to cast your net?

MESSAGE CONTENT

Plan 40 Is How to Lead; Life Class Is How to Live

This is the last week of our 40 days. In Plan 40 we have been learning **HOW TO LEAD**; in Life Class the people we bring learn **HOW TO LIVE** - in the Word and in His presence. Make sure you are registered for Life Class and the Encounter, that the people you've invited are registered too, and that they have marked the Encounter weekend as a **NO-COMPROMISE** commitment.

The Four Pillars You Guide People In

1. DEVOTION

2. CELL

3. CHURCH

4. LIFE CLASS

1. **Devotion:** 10-15 minutes a day - a habit that carries them for life.
2. **Cell:** Their spiritual home.
3. **Church:** Weekly - be faithful with the few; get them serving.
4. **Life Class:** Lessons plus application, leading to the Encounter weekend.

CELL: Compassion is not accepting excuses - it is making sure excuses don't stop people being where God wants them.

LIFE CLASS: Check they apply each lesson (week 8 is baptism - make sure they register and are prepared).

All of this requires **CONSISTENCY**. If you are inconsistent even one week, you give people an excuse to fall away. You can't be late for cell or church, or up and down in your attendance, and still expect to be the pillar others lean on. Lead by example.

Launch Out Into the Deep

Peter had fished all night and caught nothing - some of us have too. But at the word of Jesus he let down the net, and the catch was so great the nets began to break. **YOU CAN'T CATCH ANYTHING SITTING ON THE BEACH**, or sitting in a boat that never leaves the shore. Go to the deep, throw the net, and God will bring the fish. Then all you do is pull the net back into the boat - that is **CONSOLIDATION**. Afterwards Jesus said: from now on you will catch men.

Practical Ways to Cast the Net

1. **Phone Calls:** Take your list and call. Pray first: "Lord, give me the words." Include those who fell away years ago.
2. **Visits:** Nothing is as powerful as going to someone's home. Take your spouse, a brother or sister, or your triplet.
3. **Outreach:** Go where He leads - school, campus, an impoverished area, orphanage, old age home or hospital.
4. **One at a time:** You don't fill a stadium - churches fill it by inviting people one by one.

I AM A MISSIONARY

The Great Commission is not one person doing everything, but everybody doing something. Say it: **"I am a missionary."**

The root of missionary is **MISSION** - it simply means you are on a mission for the Lord. You are a missionary in your neighbourhood, your school, your workplace, your nation. And it is the **CO-MISSION** - we have this mission together.

4. Ensure **EVERY PERSON YOU'VE REACHED IS REGISTERED** for Life Class and has the Encounter weekend marked as no-compromise.
5. Prepare yourself spiritually for the Encounter: keep praying and interceding daily, and fast - even one meal or one day - trusting God for breakthrough.
6. Commit to **CONSISTENCY**: be early and present at cell and church, and get the people you're guiding involved in an area of service.
